International payments made on **Friday 29 March 2024** and **Monday 1 April 2024** will not be processed.

### SEPA Direct Debit:

Direct debits due to leave your account on **Friday 29 March 2024** and **Monday 1 April 2024** will not be debited until the next working day (**Tuesday 2 April 2024**).
