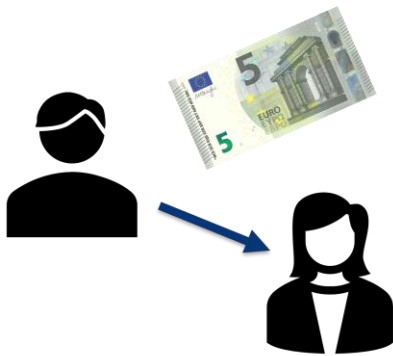

## **How do I send money from one bank account to another?**



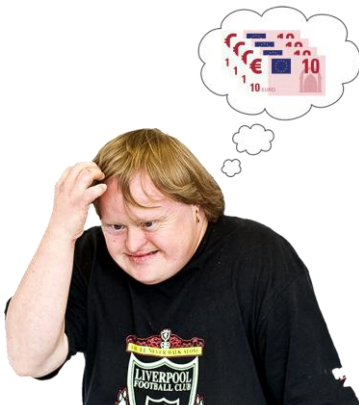
You can send money from your bank account to another bank account.

This is called a bank transfer.

It can be safer than giving money to someone.



You should only send money to someone that you know and trust.



You should know what the money is for and why you are sending the money to this person.

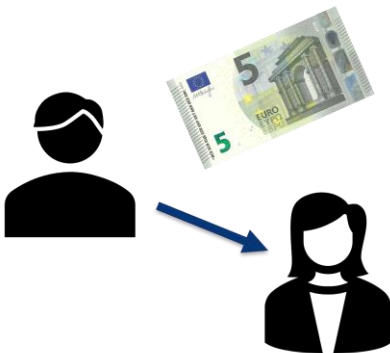


Always ask someone if you are not sure.



Watch out for scams or fraud.

This is when a person lies to you or tricks you to get money from your bank account.



If you want to send money to another bank account, here is what you need to do:



- Go to the bank. Each bank is called a branch.



- If you want, you can bring someone that you trust to support you.



- Bring your bank account number and photo identification.



- Decide how much money you want to send.



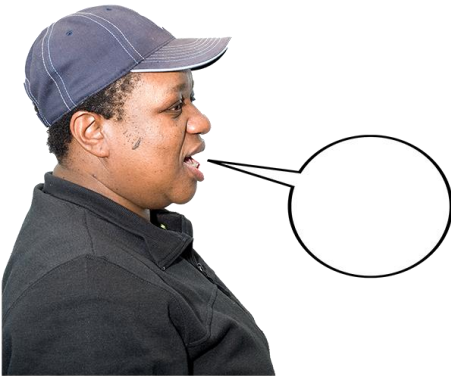
- Make sure you have enough money in your account to make the payment, and have some money left for your own things.

IE00 XXXX 654321 12345678

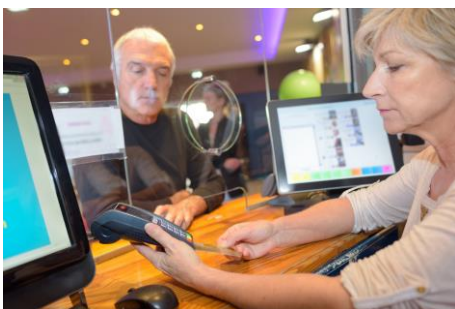
- Get the name and the bank account number of the person or company you want to pay. The account number is called the IBAN number.



- Go to the counter in the bank. Give the person working at the counter this information.



- You might want to tell the bank what the payment is for so we can put this information with the payment.



- The person working at the counter will send the money to the other account for you.



- You can also use your bank card to send money to another account.



- Make sure you know the PIN number.  
Never share your PIN number with anyone.
