How do I put money into my bank account?



Putting money into your bank account is called a lodgement.



If you want to pay money or cheques into your bank account, here is what you need to do:



- Go into your bank with your money or cheques. Each bank is called a branch.



- If you want, you can bring someone that you trust to support you.



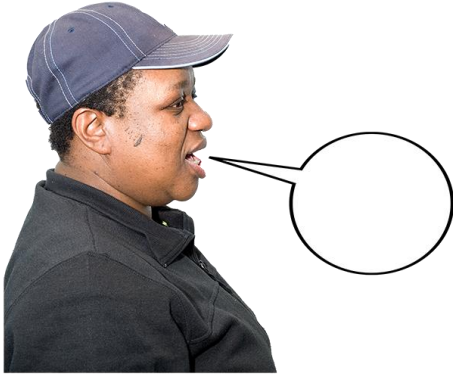
- Bring your bank account number and photo identification.



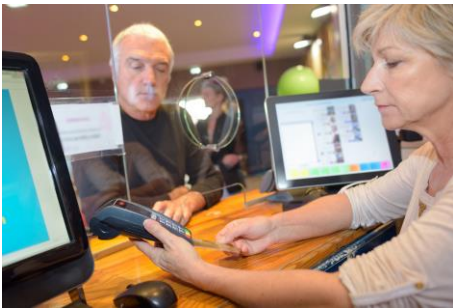
- You can ask staff in the bank if you are not sure where to go.



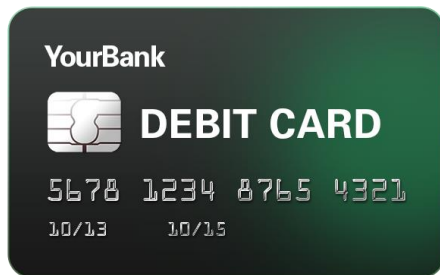
- You can go to the counter to put money into your account.



- You might want to tell the bank what the payment is for so we can put this information with the payment.



- The person working at the counter will put the money or cheques into your account.



- You can also use your bank card to put money or cheques into your account.



- Make sure you know the PIN number.
Never share your PIN number with anyone.



- There are machines in most banks that you can use to put money and cheques into your account.



- Staff in the bank can help you to use these machines.
