Getting Started is Easy

Before using the Card Reader for the first time, you must nominate the AIB Debit Card you want to use with it.

- Log in to AIB Internet Banking www.aib.ie/internetbanking
- Select the 'Manage My Accounts' option from the menu.
- Select the 'My Card Reader' tab at the top of the screen.
- Select the option 'Select your AIB Debit Card' and click start.
- Select the AIB Debit Card you wish to use and follow the onscreen instructions to complete the activation.
- If you do not have an AIB Debit Card, you can order one by calling our Card Services team on 01-2695022. There is no Government stamp duty if only used with the Card Reader.

What is the Card Reader?

The Card Reader is a security device that works in conjunction with your AIB Debit Card and PIN to generate unique security codes which are used to complete certain AIB Phone and Internet Banking transactions

How does it work?

Card Reader security uses something you have (your AIB Visa debit card) and something only you know (your Visa debit card PIN) to generate a unique eight-digit code which allows you to authorise certain transactions on AIB Phone & Internet banking.

Why do I need it?

Fraudsters are becoming more sophisticated in attempting to get access to customer's online banking details. Security experts recommend Card Readers that use your Debit Card and PIN as one of the best ways to protect you.

As the Card Reader does not hold any secure information it is not unique and can be shared if required.



What do the Function Keys mean?



Menu button – adjusts the screen contrast.

C button – clears the full screen.

button – deletes the last number displayed on the device.

OK button – is requested to confirm the requested information has been entered on the device.

to activate card reader



when applying for products online or changing credit



The **Sign** button is used when setting up or making new third party payments and changing third party details.

Using your AIB Card Reader

- 1. Insert your AIB Debit Card into the Card Reader.
- 2. Select the function you need. You will be clearly prompted to do this on AIB Internet Banking or over the phone if you are speaking with a Customer Service Adviser.
- 3. Enter your 4 digit PIN into the Card Reader. This is the PIN you enter at the ATM/POS when you use your Debit Card.
- 4. Follow the online/spoken prompts.
- 5. If asked for Account Ref, enter the last 8 numeric digits of the receivers account number or IBAN into the card reader.
